Inspector Comments: Reinspection conducted on this day as a follow-up to routine inspection conducted 8/9/22. Facility was advised to successfully eliminate cockroach infestation, take appropriate measures to prevent entrance and attraction of vermin, to clean and sanitize all affected areas, and request for a reinspection prior to opening for operation.

During reinspection two (2) pest control receipts for treatment of roaches and other vermin were observed, one for regular service dated 8/9/22 and one for follow-up service dated 8/10/22. Manager stated pest control is to resume regular monthly pest control services in September.

At the time of reinspection there was no evidence of live or dead cockroaches in any food or nonfood-contact areas of facility. All affected areas were observed cleaned and sanitized with holes and gaps in ceiling observed sealed.

Continue to take appropriate measures to maintain facility free from vermin at all times.

Facility may open for operation. See permit reinstatement comment.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Overall Inspection Comments

Reinspection conducted on this day. Permit reinstated due to elimination of cockroach infestation. Facility may open for operation.
