Inspector Comments: A complaint was referred to Environmental Health from City of San Bernardino Code Enforcement regarding overflowing sewage at KFC located at 2007 E Highland Avenue in San Bernardino. Observed water and foul smell emanating from manhole cover adjacent to facility. Shift manager stated that he was notified 2 days prior by another employee that the manhole was leaking whenever water went down the drain and had notified management. Spoke with district manager by phone; she stated that the interceptor was pumped the previous Thursday and that she could provide an invoice for service. General manager arrived and provided waste manifest and work completion forms dated 4-23-15 from Liquid Environmental Solutions. Observed comment on work completion form stating "emergency service line from trap to city line is plugged up need to get plumber".

Not In Compliance

Violation Reference - HSC

Facility closed. Closure sign posted. Plumber arrived during inspection to unclog emergency service line. Sewage overflow persisted despite plumber snaking lateral line to city main.

Violation Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.
