Inspector Comments: Observed an active vermin infestation located in critical food handling/storage areas of this establishment. Facility's current health permit is hereby suspended. Facility shall remain closed for 24-hours. A notice of closure sign has been posted at the front entrance of this facility.

Supervisory review is scheduled for Monday 6/3/2019 in the morning (exact time to be determined), located at Environmental Health Services (385 N. Arrowhead Ave., San Bernardino, 2nd FL) with supervisor Nina Garcia. Prior to resuming operation, all vermin/vermin evidence must be eliminated from the facility and all affected areas shall be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. Once compliance is achieved facility must request re-inspection and compliance will be determined by an Environmental Health Specialist with this department. When ready for re-inspection please contact this department at (800)442-2283.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409, 114405)

Inspector Comments: Observed multiple dead and living cockroaches (various life stages) in the following areas:

- floor near the front window, behind the service counter
- in front of the mop sink
- under the 3-compartment sink (multiple living and dead roaches stuck on two glue traps)
- between the stand-up freezer and a rack of fresh donuts in the back storage area

Eliminate vermin and all evidence of vermin from the facility.

Note: Permit suspended on this date due to vermin infestation. See violation #54.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed handwash sink behind the cash register to be blocked with boxes of Gatorade and two empty CO2 cylinders. Ensure handwash sink is accessible at all times.
	Not In Compliance Violation Reference -	

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

14. FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: CLEAN AND SANITIZED

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: 1. Observed no sanitizing solution readily available in buckets for use in sanitizing food contact surfaces. Ensure that sanitizing solutions are available in buckets for wiping food contact surfaces. Note: Maintain sanitizing solution at 100ppm for chlorine and 200 ppm for quaternary ammonia. Store wiping cloths in sanitizing solution in buckets prior to and after each use. This is a repeated violation. 2. Observed nozzles of cappuccino machine to have heavy build-up of food debris. Maintain food contact surfaces in a clean and sanitary manner.

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed front door propped open, with multiple flies present in the facility. Ensure to maintain front door closed to prevent entrance of vermin into the facility.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

- Repeated "four (4) point violation Risk Factor" (critical violation codes 1-23) on the last two inspections, or
- Four (4) or more critical violations (codes 1-23) noted during an inspection, or
- A permit suspension (closure) on your last graded inspection.
