

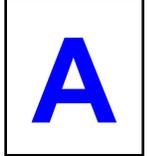

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114047, 114049, 114051	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed boxed food items stored directly on the floor of the walk in freezer unit.  Store all food items at least six inches off of the floor at all times.
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**Violation Description:** Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))

**35. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; CLEAN; GOOD REPAIR, CAPACITY**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114130, 114130.1, 114130	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the door gasket to the small refrigeration unit nearest the drive-thru window to be damaged.  Repair and maintain in good repair at all times.
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**Violation Description:** All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

**36. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114074, 114081, 114119	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a full CO2 tanks stored unsecured within the dry storage area of this facility.  Store all pressurized tanks secured to a rigid structure at all times.  -----  Observed the ice scoop stored directly within the ice of the ice bin closest to the drive-thru window.  Store this utensil out of the ice at all times.
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**Violation Description:** All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114135, 114185.1	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed multiple soiled wiping towels lying out on non-food contact surfaces.  Also, both sanitizer buckets were observed to have a sanitizer inside with a concentration between 50-100 ppm chlorine at this time.  Store all soiled wiping towels submerged within a sanitizer solution of at least 100 ppm chlorine.
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**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

**41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114171, 114189.1	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the drain line leading from the overflow drain of the soda dispenser machine nearest the drive-thru window to be leaking.  Repair and maintain in good repair.
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**Violation Description:** The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

**Violation Description:** Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placecard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406
