Inspector Comments: A reinspection was conducted on this date to verify compliance regarding a cockroach infestation. During a reinspection conducted on 5/12/2022, four (4) live cockroaches were observed under the preparation sink.

Not In Compliance

Reference - HSC

On this date, no live or dead cockroaches were observed. The previously affected areas were cleaned and sanitized. The pest control invoice from Anmart Pest Management dated 5/16/2022 stated one (1) dead nymph cockroach was observed but no cockroach activity was reported.

The wall behind the preparation sink was replaced with a new fiber-reinforced plastic (FRP) piece to ensure wall is free of holes. The floors and equipment were free of food debris and oil build-up.

Maintain the facility free from vermin at all times. Ensure any gaps in walls/ceiling are sealed to prevent vermin and rodent harborage.

Facility may reopen and permit is reinstated.

A billable reinspection will be conducted on or after seven (7) days to verify compliance.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.

Facility is cleared to open.
