POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed no paper towels at back hand-wash sink, front hand-wash sink, or bathroom hand-wash sink. Observed no soap at back hand-wash sink. Provide soap at all hand sinks. Provide paper towels in the dispensers at all times OR install heated-air hand drying devices.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

14. FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: CLEAN AND SANITIZED

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed built-up slime on soda nozzles. Observed dust build up on front sale area shelves. Clean and maintain equipment regularly. Ensure to wash, rinse, and sanitize soda nozzles daily.

34. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed expired quaternary ammonia test strips at ware-wash sink. Obtain test strips to verify quaternary ammonia sanitizer concentration level.

Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

Violation Description: Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placecard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406
