Inspector Comments: On this date of reinspection, no vermin activity was observed throughout the food facility premises. At this time, the health permit of the food facility is hereby reinstated and the facility may resume open food handling operations. The Notice of Closure was removed on this date.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

Inspector Comments: A reinspection was conducted on this date to verify proper elimination of all rodent activity observed during an inspection conducted on 11/18/2021. The health permit of the facility was suspended on that date and the facility was ordered to be closed due to an active rodent infestation. The inspector noted rodent droppings throughout the rear dry storage area of the facility near the active food preparation area.

On this date of reinspection, observed the facility to have properly cleaned and sanitized the areas of concern. Observed the facility free of rodent droppings or any additional signs of an active infestation. Upon questioning, the owner stated the facility is treated monthly by a professional pest control company called K-Town Termite & Pest Control. The owner stated the facility was professionally treated the previous night. Observed no invoice from the previous night's treatment unavailable upon request. K-Town Termite & Pest Control company was contacted by phone on this date. The company verified that this facility is regularly treated with the most recent service date of 11/18/2021. The pest control company stated new bait stations and traps were set to monitor the activity. The pest control company stated that 2 rodents were captured and removed from the facility on 11/18/2021.

At this time, the health permit of the food facility is hereby reinstated and the facility may resume open food handling operations. The Notice of Closure was removed and a Letter A placard was placed in the window. A follow-up reinspection will be conducted on or around Wednesday, 11/24/2021 to verify no rodent infestation is present in the facility. If vermin activity is observed during the follow-up reinspection, the facility may be closed with the health permit suspended. Additional billable reinspections may be charged at a fee of \$122.50 per half hour.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Overall Inspection Comments

A follow-up reinspection will be conducted on or around Wednesday, 11/24/2021 to verify no rodent infestation is present in the facility. If vermin activity is observed during the follow-up reinspection, the facility may be closed with the health permit suspended. Additional billable reinspections may be charged at a fee of \$122.50 per half hour.
