Inspector Comments: The reason this health permit was suspended was due to a rodent infestation that was observed in the warehouse and meat department in the facility.

On re-inspection this date, observed no vermin or evidence of vermin in the meat department or in the warehouse.

The permit is hereby reinstated.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

16K993 Re-Reinspection

Inspector Comments: A billable re-reinspection was conducted on this date to verify facility is free of vermin or evidence of vermin. On follow-up inspection conducted 11/4/20 the health permit to this facility was suspended due to a rodent infestation that was observed in the warehouse and meat department in the facility.

On this date, observed no vermin or evidence of vermin in the meat department or in the warehouse. Pest control receipts were reviewed from EcoLab who serviced the facility twice on 11/4/20, once on 11/5/20 and once on 11/6/20. Previous to this, pest control frequency was every two weeks. Currently, pest control service will be done weekly. Observed at least 15+ rodent traps in the meat department. Observed ceiling tiles replaced to cover holes in the ceiling in the hallway near the office and in the meat department. Operator stated additional ceiling tiles were placed to replace old ceiling tiles.

Facility is in compliance for removal of vermin and evidence of vermin and for replacing missing ceiling tiles to prevent vermin entry.

Health permit will be reinstated for the meat department.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
