Inspector Comments: A reinspection was conducted at the request of the operator.

During the routine inspection conducted on 11/27/2018, the health permit for this facility was suspended due to a live cockroach infestation that was observed in the front and rear kitchen facility.

On this date, the health permit was unable to be reinstated due a live cockroach activity that was observed in the front and rear kitchen area.

Observed three live nymph cockroaches come out from the FRP material wall behind the food preparation sink and two live nymph cockroaches come out from the FRP material wall behind the three compartment sink. In addition, observed a live nymph cockroach in the door gasket in the three door 'True' reach-in refrigeration unit and dead cockroaches inside the same refrigeration unit. Note: This refrigeration unit was turned on but no food was stored inside the refrigeration unit. Clean and sanitize the interior of the refrigerator and other affected areas. Lastly, observed two live nymph cockroaches on the lower wall in the front ware washing area and two live adult cockroaches below the ware washing station automatic dish machine. The operator showed pest control report showing service was conducted on 12/3/2018. Continue conducting proper exclusion methods to ensure this cockroach infestation is completely eliminated. The health permit was not reinstated on this date. Call this office at (800) 442-2283 when you are ready to re-open and re-inspection will be conducted to determine compliance.

Note: During this inspection, observed staff using the kitchen for food preparation purposes. Discontinue this practice as the health permit is suspended and the facility is closed.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
