Inspector Comments: A follow-up inspection was conducted on this date, 7/5/2022, to verify compliance regarding a complaint inspection conducted on 6/30/2022. Complainant stated they saw rodents in the facility.

During the complain inspection, it was noted that there were rodent droppings observed throughout the facility, particularly in the back storage area and in storage cabinets underneath the soda machine and nacho chips. A pest control invoice was not provided, and facility was instructed to eliminate the droppings and clean the affected areas.

During the follow-up inspection, observed that the same droppings that were present during the complaint inspection had not been cleaned. Spoke with the owner of the facility, who stated that the manager that was informed of the complaint did not tell them they needed to clean, and that no one was available during the weekend. The owner provided pictures from a pest control service that caught rodents in traps, and the pictures were dated as received on June 27th. An invoice was not provided. No live nor dead rodents were observed during the reinspection.

Facility is instructed to eliminate the droppings from the facility and to clean and sanitize all of the affected areas. A billed re-inspection will be conducted on or after 7/12/2022 to verify compliance. Owner was notified of the billed re-inspection charge of \$122.50 per 30 minutes. Failure to comply will result in additional billable re-inspections at a minimum charge of \$122.50 per 30 minutes.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Inspector Comments: Observed rodent droppings throughout the floors of the facility, particularly in the back storage area, as well as in storage cabinets underneath the soda machine and nacho chips.

A billed re-inspection will be conducted on or after 7/12/2022 to verify compliance. Owner was notified of the billed re-inspection charge of \$122.50 per 30 minutes. Failure to comply will result in additional billable re-inspections at a minimum charge of \$122.50 per 30 minutes.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.
