Inspector Comments: Our department received a complaint of a mouse eating out of the chips bag with droppings all around the area. The complainant added that the lady manager was informed of the situation.

The management is already aware of the situation. The male manager in charge at the time of inspection stated that the chip packages being gnawed on were discarded and the area was thoroughly cleaned. No food packages observed being gnawed on at the time of inspection. No droppings observed in the retail area. However, observed a lot of droppings in the back storage areas with setup traps. Thoroughly clean these areas. The manager stated that the facility is being maintained and treated for rodents and other vermin by the Western Exterminator Company. Observed receipts of services dated 4/2/18, 3/19/18, 2/14/18, and 1/16/18. Take effective steps to completely eliminate rodents from the facility.
