Inspector Comments: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Facility has failed to submit the missing food worker certification within fourteen (14) days resulting in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance today . Facility has to comply within 7 days to avoid future recurrent billable re-inspection. During re-inspection the manager in charge provided all the missing food handler cards for the workers names posted on the provided form . The facility will be cleared by the food worker program .

Violation Description: During your last routine inspection, it was noted that your facility was in violation of the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County. Since the inspection, food worker certification compliance has not been verified by Environmental Health staff. A billable reinspection has been conducted on this date to verify compliance.
