The complainant stated restrooms are not working and employees are not washing hands.

On this date, the employee stated both toilets was unable to use due to clog and the toilet seat broken. The manager stated

On this date, observed one toilet was clogged and the other toilet had a broken seat. Observed no handwashing violation at the time of this inspection. After thorough inspection of this facility, observed no clogging at all other sinks or sewages.

This food facility was temporarily closed for business at the time of this inspection due to unable to use all toilets.

Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.

16C006 Adequate handwashing facilities supplied & accessible

Inspector Comments: Observed missing paper towels at the two (2) handwashing sink paper towel dispensers.

Provide and maintain paper towels to all handwashing sinks at all times.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)



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16C043 Toilet facilities: properly constructed, supplied, cleaned

Inspector Comments: Observed all toilet facilities were unable to use due to clog and the toilet seat broken.

Not In Compliance

A food facility must provide toilet facilities for use by employees. Toilet facilities must be provided for patrons when there is on site consumption of food.

Violation Reference - HSC - 114250, 114276

The facility is to remain closed until permission from EHS is given. Contact your inspector at 1(800)442-2283 to schedule a reinspection to reinstate the health permit. The closure sign is posted; do not move, hide, or remove the sign.

Violation Description: Toilet facilities shall be maintained clean, sanitary and in good repair for use by employees and patrons. Toilet rooms shall be separated by a well-fitting, self-closing door. Toilet tissue shall be provided in a permanently installed dispenser at each toilet. Location of toilet facilities used by patrons shall not be located to pass through food preparation, food storage, or utensil washing areas. (114250, 114250.1, 114276)
