Person in charge stated the beef had been cooked and placed in unit the day prior. Other non- potentially hazardous food items observed to be high in temperature as well. Internal thermometer observed to read 47F.</p> <p>Ensure all potentially hazardous foods are held and maintained at 41F and below at all times.</p> <p>Corrected on site. Thermostat inside cooler was turned on its lowest point. Beef voluntarily discarded and condemned, see VC&D for details. Cook was instructed to ensure thermostat remains on low so temperatures can br maintained. A follow up will be conducted to ensure this unit has the ability to hold PHF at 41F and below.</p>
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Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

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Violation Description: All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. Main cold holding unit across from cook line observed to have three containers of standing water condensation within it. Discontinue this practice. Contact maintenance and make necessary repairs. A follow up will be conducted to ensure compliance.

Observed multiple floor areas through the back kitchen in need of deep cleaning and sanitation. 2.) Observed floor drain next to ice maker to have buildup and debris accumulated. Clean and maintain all floors throughout facility.
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Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))
