Inspector Comments: On April 26th during a plan check consultation a live rodent was observed in the facility. Open food portion of facility was closed.

On May 17th per operator's request to reopen a follow-up inspection was conducted. Facility was observed with many fresh rodent droppings, and food items gnawed. Facility was closed. Food and drinks prohibited for sale.

On May 18th per operator's request to reopen a follow-up billable inspection was conducted. Facility observed with rodent droppings. Many holes and gaps were observed on walls and ceiling of facility.

On this date per operator's request to reopen a follow-up billable inspection was conducted. Facility was observed clean and sanitized. No rodent droppings were observed. Holes and gaps were observed to be covered. All food items were observed clean and in good condition.

Facility may now reopen.
