Inspector Comments: No evidence of an active rodent infestation was observed on this date. Observed the facility to have been treated by a professional pest control service (Dewey Pest Control Company). Observed the facility clean and free of rodent droppings. At this time, the health permit is hereby reinstated and the facility may resume food preparation.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

Inspector Comments: A reinspection was conducted on this date to verify proper elimination of all vermin from the facility.

A complaint investigation was conducted on 9/22/2020 in response to a complaint received by Environmental Health Services on 9/20/2020 in regards to rodent activity in the facility. During the complaint investigation conducted on 9/22/2020, the inspector observed evidence of an active rodent infestation and the health permit of the facility was suspended on that date. During the complaint investigation, fresh rodent droppings were observed underneath the cabinet area behind the front register, inside an open box of individual packages of mayonnaise, behind the Pepsi refrigeration unit, and in the cabinet underneath the customer beverage self-service area. An invoice was provided by the operator stating the facility was treated by Dewey Pest Control Company on 9/22/2020.

On this date, a Supervisory Review was conducted with a Supervising Environmental Health Specialist at Environmental Health Services located at 385 N. Arrowhead Avenue, San Bernardino. The operator provided an invoice stated the facility was serviced by Dewey Pest Control Company on 9/23/2020. According to the invoice, the Pest Control Technician did not observe any signs of rodent activity on this date. A thorough inspection was conducted throughout the entire facility on this date and no signs of rodent activity were observed. Observed the facility to have properly cleaned and sanitized all areas where rodent activity was observed during the complaint investigation. All food was observed in good condition and unadulterated at time of reinspection.

Continue to take appropriate measures to prevent the entrance and harborage of vermin including but not limited to rodents, cockroaches, and flies. At this time, the health permit is hereby reinstated and the facility may now resume operations.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Overall Inspection Comments

NOTE: Recommend replacing the weatherstripping along the front entrance doors with a brushed metal weatherstrip to prevent the entrance of vermin into the facility.
