Inspector Comments: This re-reinspection was requested by the person in charge of this food facility.

The purpose of this re-reinspection was to determine compliance regarding facility closure due to evidences of active rodent infestation.

OBSERVATION(S):

Continue observed evidences of rodent infestation in this food facility. Observed a large amount (about more than 60) of dry rodents droppings in 3 wood cabinets at the cash register. Observed a small amount (about 10 - 12) of dry droppings at the following area: under the dish washer, at the corner under the dry food storage rack next to the ice machine.

Observed about 30 - 40 empty rodent paper glue trap around the kitchen and dining area. Observed pest control receipt indicated 3 mice were caught on 6/5/19.

Remove all evidences of rodent infestation off this food facility.

RESULT(S):

Facility remained closed. Permit remained suspended. Closure sign remained posted at the front entrance window.

This facility shall not open without permission from Environmental Health Service of San Bernardino County. Closure sign remained posted. Do not deface, mar, camouflage, relocate, hide, or remove.

Failure to comply will result in billable reinspection with an hourly rate of \$245.00 per hour with a minimum charge of \$122.50.

Clean and sanitized all contaminated or suspected of contamination areas.
Discarded all contaminated food or suspected of contamination food items.

Any rodent dropping shall result in facility closure continuance.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
