

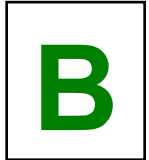

Inspector Comments: Observed formations of black mold-like residue on the upper panel of the interior of the ice machine. The substance was observed to be dripping and coming in contact with the ice inside of the ice machine.

Remove, clean, and sanitize all accumulations on the interior upper panel of ice machine, and ensure ice machine is maintained clean and free of any growth or accumulation.

Note: See VC&D below.

Violation Description: All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. 7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES ⚠ MAJOR ⚠

Inspector Comments: Measured the following potentially hazardous food (PHF) stored in the front cold holding unit across from the flat griddle stove:
- Pork Sausage (55F- 56F)

Operator stated items were held inside the cold holding unit for more than six (6) hours and ambient temperature observed at 45 F. Observed pooling of water on the bottom of the cold holding unit.

Recommendation: Discontinue use of this cold holding unit until repaired or replaced. Maintain all potentially hazardous foods in cold holding at 41 F or below.

Note: See VC&D below.

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

26. APPROVED THAWING METHODS USED, FROZEN FOOD

Inspector Comments: Observed multiple bags of raw chicken to be defrosting in the food prep sink without running water or other approved methods. Operator stated the chicken products were left at room temperature to allocate defrosting.

Ensure foods are thawed via the following approved method: under refrigeration, under running water(no higher than 70F), in a microwave, or during the cooking process.

Violation Description: Food shall be thawed under refrigeration; completely submerged under cold running water (less than 70F) of sufficient velocity to flush loose particles for less than 2 hours; in microwave oven; or during the cooking process. (114018, 114020, 114020.1)

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Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

Discontinue this practice. Ensure all utensils are cleaned and placed in proper storage.
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Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

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Violation Description: Operator has voluntarily consented to the condemnation and destruction of food as said material being unfit for human consumption or otherwise in violation of California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 5, Chapter 1 through 8, the disposition of which is provided for by Chapter 8, Article 3, Section 111895.

"I (We) hereby voluntarily agree to the condemnation and destruction of the following material(s) listed in violation number 52. By signing this Official Inspection Report (OIR), I (We) hereby release the County of San Bernardino and its agent from any and all liability."
