Inspector Comments: The purpose of this follow-up was conducted per operators request.

On 9/22/20 this facility was closed during a routine inspection due to an imminent health hazard. Facility was observed with rodent droppings on the floor, food storage racks, and all along loft storage area. Several prepackaged candy boxes were observed bitten through.

A supervisory review was scheduled on 9/24/20 to discuss re-opening of facility.

On 9/24/20 EHS inspector conducted an inspection and observed new rodent activity. Health permit was not reinstated.

On 9/25/20 EHS inspector conducted a billable inspection new rodent activity was observed on loft and holes throughout loft had not been sealed. Health permit was not reinstated.

On this date a billable reinspection was conducted. One rodent dropping was observed in a hard to reach area. No holes were observed in loft area. Person in charge stated holes had been sealed. Person in charge stated a cleaning crew had cleaned facility on the weekend. A request for the recent pest control was requested but was not provided.

Upon arrival facility was observed closed.

On this date the health permit for this facility has been reinstated, this facility may now operate.

A one week reinspection will be conducted on 10/5/20 to verify facility continues compliance agreement which follows:

- All rodents are to have been eliminated from facility
- Management shall verify the facility has been thoroughly cleaned and sanitized and will be maintained.
- Maintain the building to prevent the entry of rodents; seal all holes in the walls and ceilings with material that will prevent the entry of rodents.
- Facility will monitor rodent activity and will self-close if evidence of rodents is found.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.
