Inspector Comments: On this date a complaint investigation was conducted along with a routine inspection due to complaint (CO0083116) received on May 10, 2022 by San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services.

Nature of complaint:
Per complainant, while eating their burrito they found a metal wire in it.

Interview with manager:
Per manager, they were aware of the complaint. The manager stated they were unsure where the metal wire came from.

Observation:
No loose metal wires were observed during inspection. The food observed on this date was free of contamination. Station where burritos are made was free from any contamination and metal foreign objects. All equipment observed on this date was commercially approved equipment.

Multiple containers of food were observed to be uncovered and unprotected through out the facility. See violation 16C030.

Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.
