Inspector Comments: Permit reinstated as of 3/9/19 due to confirmation of two (2) negative water samples obtained on 3/7/19 and 3/8/19, 24 hours apart. Results of both samples were confirmed 3/9/19, which rescinded boil water notice.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

16K994 Reinspection

Inspector Comments: Follow-up inspection conducted on this day to reopen facility who was closed 3/7/19. On that day, a boil water notice was issued by County Service Area 42 (CSA 42) due to confirmation that well #1 had tested positive for e. coli from water sample obtained 3/6/19, making water non-potable. In order to rescind boil water notice, two negative water samples, obtained 24 hours apart, must be obtained.

On Saturday, 3/9/19, negative results of samples obtained on 3/7/19 and 3/8/19 were confirmed, which rescinded boil water notice. Owner of facility spoke with EHS supervisor via phone same day, who provided verbal authorization to remove the closure sign and reopen facility once the boil water notice was lifted. At approximately noon on 3/9/19, facility removed closure notice and began operating.

During follow-up inspection, "A" grade placard was replaced. No further action required.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Permit reinstated. "A" grade placard was replaced. No further action required.
