Inspector Comments: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Facility has failed to submit the missing food worker certification within fourteen (14) days resulting in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance today. Facility has to comply within 7 days to avoid future recurrent billable re-inspection. Observed the missing food handler cards during re-inspection and facility will be cleared.
