Inspector Comments: Complainant observed no social distancing being enforced within the facility. Facility signs state maximum of 4 people inside the facility at a time but observed at least 6. Complainant also observed that both employees and customers were not wearing face masks despite signs stating otherwise.

Reference - HSC

Operator stated that social distancing signs and face mask signs are in place at the facility but that he will make sure that it is more properly enforced going forward. Stated that customers tend to turn the chairs around inside and sit down while waiting for their order but will now completely tape off the seating area and have customers wait outside for their orders. Social distancing markers were placed but came off due to foot traffic, owner will replace immediately.
