On May 17, 2022, our office received a complaint concerning your facility. In the complaint, the complainant alleged that your facility had a "dead rat" like odor. No other information was provided.

Observations / Investigation:

A rodent infestation was identified during a routine inspection of the facility conducted on April 12, 2022. No live or dead rodent were observed, but numerous rodent fecal pellets were observed in the back storage area.

Although the facility has made good progress in removing clutter and rodent dropping, rodent droppings were observed during this reinspection. No live or dead rodent were observed.

The owner stated that he has retained a pest control company to control the rats. The pest control operator sealed exterior entry points on the building and recommended the owner have a landscaper cut back vegetation around the building. Observed both screened off exterior holes and trimmed palm tree adjacent to the building.

DIRECTIVE:

The facility will require further reinspections to ensure ALL evidence of rodent infestation has been eliminated.

\* Remove all rodent pellets from inside cabinets and around the flood perimeter.

\* Remove all unnecessary equipment, trash or other unneeded items to eliminate rodent harborage.

\* Continue with pest control activities.
