Facility may reopen under the following conditions:

Roof has been repaired and no longer leaking in any preparation areas and food storage areas.

All food preparation areas, equipment, and food and utensil storage areas have been cleaned and sanitized.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409, 114405)
