Inspector Comments: Purpose: A billable inspection was conducted today to re-open facility. On Friday, April 16th facility was closed due to vermin. On Saturday, April 17th facility was given temporary permission to open with a follow-up billable inspection on April 19th.

Observed: Inspection was conducted with owner, manager, and pest control technician. Observed dry droppings at the following area:

- Main cook line (cooling racks); observed one mice dropping
- Floors located in warewash area; observed 3 mice droppings
- Upstairs storage area, both room and china storage; observed 4 mice droppings
- Handsink area located in bar area; observed 2 mice droppings
- Mop area; observed 2 mice droppings

Observed areas of concern:

- Front door, 1/2" opening possible vermin entry point. Seal and maintain
- Ceiling panel open located in 2nd floor storage room
- Employee back door break room, keep door closed at all times
- Facility outdoor space has empty field, palm trees and lots of foliage
- Facility trash bin open, keep closed to prevent vermin activity

Result: A 24 hour re-inspection will be conducted to determine facility has cleaned and sanitized all areas of vermin (mice droppings). A second billable inspection will be held on April 20th.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.

Overall Inspection Comments

A 2nd billable inspection will be conducted on April 20th.
