Inspector Comments: Reinspection conducted on this day as follow-up to routine inspection conducted 3/2/22. On that day, one (1) live adult german cockroach and three (3) dead german cockroaches were observed in facility. Owner was advised to obtain approved pest control methods to eliminate all live cockroaches, and remove dead cockroaches from facility, as well as clean all food debris on floors and equipment, as well as on utensils. Owner was also advised to clean and sanitize all possible contaminated areas and seal all holes and gaps that could allow entry of vermin.

During reinspection, floors of facility was observed clean with holes and gaps in walls observed sealed. Dead cockroaches observed removed, however, additional dead cockroaches were observed on floor beneath stand-up reach-in-coolers. One (1) live adult german cockroach and one (1) live nymph german cockroach observed on floor beneath stand-up reach-in-coolers.

Permit suspended and facility closed due to infestation of cockroaches (se permit suspension comment).

Inspector Comments: One (1) live adult german cockroach and one (1) live nymph german cockroach was observed on floor beneath stand-up reach-in-coolers, with dead cockroaches also on floor beneath stand-up reach-in-coolers.

During complaint and routine inspections conducted 3/2/22, owner stated pest control services facility once per month. At that time, invoices observed indicated facility was treated for german cockroaches on 2/23/22, 1/28/22, 12/28/21 and 11/19/21. Owner stated when pest control was contacted after inspection, pest control advised owner of facility that retreating facility is not permitted within seven (7) days of last treatment, and is scheduled to revisit facility Monday, 3/14/22.

Obtain approved pest control methods to eliminate all live cockroaches, and remove dead cockroaches from facility. Clean all food debris on floors and equipment, as well as on utensils. Ensure all possible contaminated areas are properly cleaned and sanitized prior to reinspection.

Reinspection required in no less than twenty-four (24) hours to ensure elimination of vermin from facility. Failure to eliminate vermin and clean and sanitize all contaminated areas will result in a charged reinspection to verify compliance.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
