Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit was to conduct a follow up inspection, as indicated in the billable reinspection conducted on 6/18/2018 to verify continued compliance with vermin proofing the facility and elimination of the rodent infestation within the facility.

- The electrical box near the secondary customer entrance nearest 29 Palms Hwy was observed to be temporarily covered with duct tape.
- One old dropping was found in the kitchen area under the counter at the front of the kitchen near the set trap. This dropping was removed from the facility.
- Several set traps were observed throughout the facility, no rodent activity was observed. All traps were rodent free and observed snapped.
- No fresh droppings were observed in the facility.
- Dewey Pest control records were observed for follow up treatment conducted on this date, 6/18/2018. Per the records no droppings were observed, no rodent activity was observed in the facility, one chewed box was observed on the exterior of the building. Dewey Pest control has scheduled a follow up to be conducted on 6/20/2018.

On this date (6/25/2018) the following was observed:

- one fresh dropping observed in the dry storage area on top of the cup storage box.
- Pest control records were observed for 6/22/2018. The record indicated one small rodent was caught in the back storage area. 8 glue traps were placed. Follow up for pest control was scheduled by Dewey pest control on 6/25/2018.
- Pest control records were observed for the 6/25 Dewey pest control follow up service conducted this date. The records indicated that one rodent was caught in the back beverage storage area. and onion was observed with signs of chewing. Per the person in charge the onions were discarded and the rodent was removed from the facility by pest control. A follow up with Dewey Pest control is scheduled for 6/27/2018.

Continue to eliminate the infestation and evidence of an infestation. Manager has been instructed to continue efforts to eliminate harborage and elimination of pests and evidence of pests from the facility. Continue to thoroughly clean all areas where rodent droppings/activity have been observed during recent inspections. Provide your local health inspector follow ups regarding progress by sending the Pest control records via email or text to your health inspector, including Dewey pest control documents immediately after their follow ups.

Inspector Comments: On this date one rodent dropping was observed in the dry storage area on top of a box of cups. Clean and sanitize all food contact surfaces. Maintain the facility free from rodents, roaches, flies, and other vermin. Remove all evidence of the infestation from the facility.

On this date one rodent was caught by pest control services and one chewed onion was observed by pest control services. The onions were discarded by employees prior to this inspection, the rodent was removed from the facility by pest control services.

A billed re-inspection will be conducted in one weeks time to verify compliance.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.
