Inspector Comments: On November 16, 2020, our office received a complaint concerning your facility. In the complaint, the complainant alleged that he / she observed "rat droppings" throughout the store and on the beverage dispenser.

Investigation:

On January 12, 2021, our office conducted a routine inspection of the Centerpoint Car Wash convenience store. The facility received a letter grade of "C" and a score of 77 / 100 points. Per San Bernardino County ordinance, because the facility received a letter "C" grade, the owner must arrange to have a reinspection conducted within thirty (30) days of the routine inspection, and received a letter grade "B" or higher, or may have their health permit revoked.

During the inspection, rodent fecal pellets and rodent damaged prepackaged food (sunflower seeds) were observed. This discovery, along with a lack of hot water (water in excess of 100 F), resulted the closure and suspension of the non-prepackaged portion of the facility's health permit. Pending further review, the facility was allowed to continue with prepackage sales of food and beverages.

The facility must receive a complete reinspection within thirty (30) days in which all violations identified must be corrected. In the interim, the facility will receive follow up inspections to ensure the correction of the rat infestation and lack of hot water.

Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.
