Seal any/all gaps/crevices in the facility.
Clean and sanitize all the affected areas prior to contacting inspector for reopening.

Prior to a re-opening inspection being conducted, all evidence of cockroach activity must be eliminated from the facility to avoid a possible billed re-inspection.

Violation Description: Violation(s) observed pose an immediate threat to public health and safety and the health permit to operate is hereby suspended and ordered closed until the listed violation(s) have been corrected and verified by DEHS. Facility is to remain closed until permission from DEHS is given. Contact your inspector at your local office to schedule a reinspection to reinstate the health permit. NATURE OF COMPLAINT:
The complainant stated a cockroach climbed on seat next to them while they were eating.

FINDING(S):
The manager stated that they have not heard of this nor any similar complaint. According to the manager pest control services facility monthly.

OBSERVATION(S):

- Observed last pest control receipt from March 6th, 2020.
- Observed four slow moving cockroaches in the following areas:
 - One adult cockroach on floor by the entrance door to kitchen from dining area.
 - One nymph cockroach on floor next to "Alto-Shaam" ovens.
 - Two nymph cockroaches on floor next to table holding meat slicer.
- Observed three live cockroaches in following areas:
 - One nymph cockroach on floor underneath unused ventilation hood.
 - One adult cockroach on blue tubing underneath employee break table.
 - One adult on side of safe in front service area.
