A complaint inspection was conducted on this date in response to complaint number CO0081274.

NATURE OF COMPLAINT:

The complainant alleged that there has been sights of rodents within the kitchen and dry storage area.

OBSERVATION:

1) On this date, the manager was interviewed. The manager stated the following items:

- The facility was not aware of this complaint
- To his knowledge, there has been no sight of vermin or evidence of vermin inside the facility at this time
- Sighting of vermin or evidence of vermin was found outside of the facility at the back delivery area
- Pest control inspections are conducted once a month.
- The most recent pest control inspection was conducted on 11/16/2021. All comments noted on the pest control inspection was corrected at the time.

2) On this date, the following was observed:

- Proof of the most recent inspection report conducted on 11/16/2021
- Approximately (2) to (4) dry rodent droppings located on the flooring behind the electrical panel
- Approximately (3) dry rodent droppings within the three-door reach-in refrigerator unit located below the cream pies sign
- Approximately (2) dry rodent droppings located on the flooring below the soda syrup metal rack

After a thorough search of the facility, observed no active infestation of vermin at this time.

OUTCOME:

A follow up inspection will be conducted on 12/3/2021 to verify the facility is clean, sanitized, and free of rodent droppings.

Failure to comply may result in future billable follow up inspections.

No further action is warranted at this time. The complaint will be closed.

After a thorough search of the facility, observed no active infestation of vermin at this time. Per manager, pest control inspections are conducted once a month Observed the most recent inspection report conducted on 11/16/2021.

Immediately clean and sanitize the affected areas. Eliminate all vermin and evidence of vermin from this facility including but not limited to rodents.

A follow up inspection will be conducted on 12/3/2021 to verify compliance.

Failure to comply may result in future billable follow up inspections.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies.
