Inspector Comments: A follow-up inspection was conducted at this time to determine compliance of keeping facility free of vermin. Owner provided pest control receipt that indicated that pest control treated the facility earlier this morning and observed German cockroaches. Facility was cleaned and sanitized.

At the time of this inspection, observed about five (5) live cockroaches. Observed one live adult and live nymph cockroach inside black pest control box. Upon questioning, the owner explained that property management provided that facility with black pest control box. Observed that pest control box to be completely full with dead cockroaches. Observed one nymph cockroach crawling on the wall behind the reach-in freezer by the office. Observed two (2) nymph cockroaches behind the reach-in cooler in front of the walk-in cooler; one on the wall and the other crawling on the floor.

Informed owner that this facility is to remain closed until all vermin or any evidence of vermin is removed from the facility. Facility will need to be cleaned and sanitized.
Ensure food facility is maintained free of vermin or evidence of vermin activity. Closure sign was left by the front entrance.

A charged follow-up inspection will be conducted on or after 3/5/21, per owner's request, to determine compliance. Failure to comply will result in another charged follow-up inspection.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Overall Inspection Comments

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a follow-up inspection for vermin infestation of cockroaches during the routine inspection.
