Inspector Comments: -On Thursday May 30, 2019 an EHS inspector suspended World Buffet health permit due to an imminent health hazard of vermin infestation. Notice of closure sign was posted on May 30th. After 24 hours and a supervisor review at the Rancho Cucamonga office, facility called EHS to conduct a reinspection stating their facility had been clean and sanitized. Friday May 31, 2019 during the reinspection rodent droppings were still observed. Facility was not permitted to reopen and permit suspension continued.

Saturday June 1, 2019 a follow-up was conducted to ensure facility was not operating. Upon arrival Notice of Closure sign was not observed at the front entrance. Doors were open to the public and customers were observed to be dining. Facility was operating and serving customers with a suspended permit.

Person in Charge stated owner believed the inspector had given him permission to reopen during the reinspection on Friday May 31. Inspection report for May 31 states facility could not reopen, person in charge signed on May 31.

-On this date facility was closed immediately. When person in charge was asked about the notice of closure sign he stated it was posted at the front entrance. At that point an employee had reposted Notice of closure sign at the entrance.

Person in charge was advised to not reopen facility until an EHS inspector reinstated health permit and officially removed Notice of closure sign.

-Paper copy of Official inspection report was given to person in charge on this date.

-Official inspection report (paper copy) was sign by person in charge and can be provided upon request.

Description: Obtain a valid health permit within 3 days or as specified to avoid facility closure and/or other possible legal action.

Overall Inspection Comments

On this date facility was observed to be operating with a suspended permit.

A follow-up inspection was conducted to verify World buffet was not operating due to a suspended permit.

Facility was closed immediately.
