Inspector Comments:

PURPOSE:

A billable re-re-inspection was conducted on this date to observe compliance with the three compartment sink drain lines. It was noted during the routine inspection that the drain lines were separated from the bottom of the three compartment sink allowing gray water to spill onto the floor. At the time, the cook was able to reattach the drain lines to the three compartment sink preventing a closure. During a follow up inspection, it was noted that the drain line for the three compartment sink was disconnected from the wall sewer line allowing the three compartment sinks gray water to spill onto the floor. At the time the cook was able to temporarily reattach the line. A billable follow up inspection was conducted on this date to observe compliance with the three compartment.

OBSERVATION:

Observed all the drain lines to be firmly attached to the three compartment sink and the wall sewer line. The drain line for the three compartment sink was observed to be clogged. Observed water ran in the middle compartment of the three compartment sink caused the water back up in the other two compartments. Observed standing water in all three compartments of the three compartment sink.

OUTCOME:

Discontinue the use of the three compartment sink until the necessary repairs have been completed. With no approved method of sanitizing utensils the facility is hereby closed and the permit suspended. An impound/embargo sticker was placed onto the three compartment sink.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.

The facility is to remain closed until permission from DEHS has been given. Contact San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services to schedule a re-inspection to reinstate the health permit. The sink is hereby embargoed, cease and desist the use of the three compartment sink until the necessary repairs have been conducted and authorization has been given by Environmental Health Services.

With no approved method of sanitizing utensils the facility is hereby closed and the permit suspended.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)
