Inspector Comments: A follow up inspection was conducted on this date to verify compliance of cleaning and sanitizing areas where rodent droppings were found during the initial complaint inspection conducted on 9/20/22.

During the time of reinspection, manager was able to show proof of most recent pest control invoices stating that they have been treating daily. Facility was observed to be free of rodent droppings. The back dry storage area was observed to be clean and holes have been patched and covered. The soda machine area was observed to be clean and no rodent droppings observed during the time of inspection.

No further action is required at this time. The health permit is hereby reinstated and the Notice of Closure sign has been removed. The facility may now reopen the open food section to the public.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
