**Inspector Comments:** Environmental Health received a complaint stating for over a month, there has been no running water. No water is available for hand washing or using the restroom. The smell was horrible and customers complained to the the employees and store manager. Some of the food and drinks are expired and not rotated correctly. There are dead bugs through the store. The store is always dirty and the store manager doesn't try to fix it. There are mouse traps in the store also.

Discussed nature of complaint with manager. Manager stated water has been not functioning for approximately a month now due to part of water system located outdoors was stolen. Part was replaced and stolen again same day. Water has been not functioning since, preventing employees to wash hands and keeping facility from being cleaned.

Replace part for water within 24 hours to provide running water.

Mouse traps are placed in office and rear of facility by pest control to ensure no infestation occurs.

Due to lack of water, health permit suspended to prevent the sale of all food and beverages. Aisles of food were blocked off to prevent guests from shopping. Reinspection required prior to selling food.
