Observed the following in rear storeroom area:

1. Pots, pans, utensils for preparing and cooking food
2. NSF (Hoodmart) exhaust hood
3. Wolf 6-burner stove, oven, grill combo
4. 5 rolls of stickers placed on burritos in hot holding that say--Big Pine Chevron 356 N. Main St., Big Pine, CA phone--760-938-2626
5. 3-door Superior food prep refrigerator full of prepared (cooked) meat dishes, condiments (tomatoes, peppers) not covered.
6. one door True refrigerator full of diced ham, eggs, cheese, lunch meat, diced onions, peppers-not covered
7. wall shelves have spices, canned food and bread
8. walk in refrigerator has home style chest freezer full of meat (no labels), unlabeled foods in containers looking like salsas, refried beans, chili sauce and chile rellenos

Description: Obtain a valid health permit within 3 days or as specified to avoid facility closure and/or other possible legal action.
