Inspector Comments: This department has received a complaint regarding this facility. Complainant states there are rats in the food section of the store and that employees are aware of the issue, but management has not taken care of it.

Spoke to the manager regarding the complaint. She states facility has had an issue with rats for the last few months. Facility is currently being treated on a daily basis by Terminix. Observed traps set in back storage area as well as below some store shelves. During this inspection, rat droppings were observed on the floor throughout the facility as well as on the store shelves. Droppings were also seen on boxes in back storage area. Bags of pasta and rice and boxes of chicken broth were observed to have been damaged as well as other non-food items.

This facility is closed due to vermin infestation.

Remove all affected food items from store shelves and storage area. Clean and sanitize all areas where droppings are found. Seal all holes in ceiling and any other holes found throughout facility in order to prevent vermin entry. Weatherstrip back door in storage area to eliminate gaps. This facility will remain closed until vermin infestation has been abated.

Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.

16K054 Permit Suspension

Remove all affected food items from store shelves.

Violation Description: All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. 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16K023 No rodents, insects, birds, or animals

Inspector Comments: Rodent droppings observed throughout facility, on floors and store shelving.

Immediately abate vermin infestation and keep facility free of vermin.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

16K044 Premises; personal/cleaning items; vermin-proofing

Inspector Comments: Observed gaps at back door in storage area and holes in ceiling throughout the store.

Violation Reference - HSC - 114067 (j), 114123

Seal all holes in facility and weatherstrip back door to eliminate any gaps.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

Overall Inspection Comments

This facility is closed due to vermin infestation. Closure sign posted. Facility is to remain closed until reinspection by this department. Contact this department at 909-442-2283 for reinspection when vermin infestation has been abated. If at time of reinspection the issue persists, a second, billed reinspection will be conducted at a rate of \$245 per hour, half hour minimum.
