Not In Compliance Reference - HSC **Inspector Comments:** This reinspection was conducted as a result of the routine inspection conducted on 10/06/2020. This facility health permit was suspended due to lack of hot water (87 F).

On this reinspection, The hot water at all sinks (two handwashing sinks, one 3-compartment sink, one mop sink, and two restroom handwashing sinks) were measured above 120 degree F. The manager stated the water heater was turned off.

No further action warranted. The Notice of Closure sign was removed, and the new letter graded "B" sign posted on the window next to the front entrance. Do not remove, relocate, or obscure from public view.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
