Inspector Comments: A billed reinspection was conducted by the San Bernardino County Division of Environmental Health. The purpose of this second reinspection is to determine compliance regarding closure due to vermin infestation.

Upon arrival to facility observed soda machine off and ice machine off.

Observed the following:

- Four large live cockroaches inside of unused ice machine in the back of the facility.
- One small slow moving small cockroach underneath the three compartment sink.
- One small live cockroach underneath handwash sink.
- Two small live cockroaches on the floor in the aisle way across the soda machine.
- Two small live cockroaches on the floor in the sales aisle.

Operator stated that the facility has been providing their own pest control and cleaning since previous inspection. Operator also stated that professional pest control service will be servicing facility on 10/8/2020.

Advised operator to keep pest control receipt after facility has been serviced, to clean and sanitize areas affected by cockroaches. Operator stated they have plans to repair the unused ice machine.

Permit is to remain suspended until facility is free of live vermin. Another billed inspection will be conducted in approximately two days to verify compliance.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
