Inspector Comments: Environmental Health has received an alleged foodborne illness complaint stating that the requester purchased fudge that is made at facility, took it home and noticed a chemical odor. Requester then tasted the fudge and became nauseous and throat began to hurt. Requester returned the suspect fudge.

Upon complaint inspection the following information was provided by manager on duty:

Discussed nature of complaint with manager on duty. This manager was not on duty at the time when customer returned the suspect fudge, but was made aware of the incident. Manager states that all of the fudge was removed and a new batch of fudge was made.

Observations:

All chemicals stored in janitorial closet or in cabinets. No chemical cross contamination factors observed at this time.

Description: A foodborne illness complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.
