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**18. COMPLIANCE WITH VARIANCE, SPECIALIZED PROCESS, & HACCP PLAN**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed rice at 80F at prep table. Per operator, rice was cooked at 9:00am, vinegar was added to rice and pH level was verified at 4.4. Operator unable to provide HACCP plan or proof of lab testing.  If HACCP plan not approved, ensure time or temperature is used to control bacteria growth in all potentially hazardous foods.  Verified rice pH was 4.4. Allowed operator to use remaining batch of rice. Operator stated time will be used to control bacteria.

**Violation Description:** HACCP Plan is a written document that delineates the formal procedures developed for safe food handling approved by the National Advisory Committee on Microbiological Criteria for Foods (114419). A written document approving a deviation from standard health code requirements shall be maintained at the food facility (114057, 114057.1). Food facility operator must submit for an HACCP approval or follow an approved HACCP plan.

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed debris on knife stored on magnetic strip. Ensure utensils are clean before storing.  Observed scoop handle touching food in bulk bin. Store scoop handle so that it does not directly contact food.

**Violation Description:** All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed wet wiping cloth stored on cutting board.  Store wet wiping cloths in approved sanitizer solution.

**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

**41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed lack of air gap between refrigerator drainlines and floor sink.  Maintain at least 1-inch air gap between drainpipes and floor sink to prevent backflow contamination.

**Violation Description:** The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

**Inspector Comments:** Observed air curtain not operating when delivery door opened.  
 Maintain air curtain in operation when the delivery door is open.  
 Operator switched air curtain back on.

**Violation Description:** The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)
