Nature of complaint: Rodents/Rats inside of the facility.

Interview: Upon interview, the manager stated that he was aware of this complaint. The last pest control service was on 04/16/2021, where rodent activity was observed. Manager stated that their pest control services will continue to return every 3-5 days. Traps have been set up underneath the dish machine and throughout the facility away from food.

Observations: Observed two (2) fresh rodent droppings underneath the warewashing machine.

A follow up inspection will be conducted on or after 05/05/2021.

Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.
