<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Complied on 8/21/2015 Violation Reference -	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a line cook handle raw chicken, remove his gloves, then handle ready to eat products from the coldpan unit; Employees shall wash their hands when switching between working with raw food and working with ready-to-eat food.
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**Violation Description:** Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Complied on 8/21/2015 Violation Reference - HSC - 113996, 113998, 114037	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed two different butter based wing sauces sitting on top of ice 52-60 degrees F; All cold potentially hazardous foods [PHF] shall be maintained at or below 41°F. Voluntarily condemned and destroyed.
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**Violation Description:** Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference -	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the warewashing area handwashing sink has a pan on top of it, and the line handwashing sink has a trash can in front of it; A handwashing facility shall be clean, unobstructed, and accessible at all times for employee use.
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**Violation Description:** Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

**34. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114067(f,g), 114099	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed no detectable sanitizer in the waitress area wipe down bucket; If used repeatedly, cloths used for cleaning shall be held in a sanitizing solution of an approved concentration (200 ppm of quaternary ammonia [Quat]).
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**Violation Description:** Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

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**Violation Description:** All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)



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**38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA**

POINTS <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed gaps in the mechanical exhaust grease filters; Filters shall be tight fitting and firmly held in place and grease filters shall be arranged so that all exhaust air passes through the grease filters.

**Violation Description:** Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

**44. PREMISES; PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING**

POINTS <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the front doors are left open; Doors are not to remain open, except when receiving deliveries and an ANSI approved air curtain must be operating at that time.

**Violation Description:** The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

**48. FOOD HANDLER CERTIFICATION**

POINTS <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed six (6) staff members lack approved food worker cards; No person shall work or allow the employment of any person as a food handler within this jurisdiction except when such food handler possesses an unexpired, unsuspended, unrevoked food handler card or a certificate. Facility has two (2) weeks to submit approved SBC food worker cards to EHS or a Charged reinspection will occur. Facility must contact the FIRST Program at 800-442-2283 Http://www.sbcfoodworker.com

**Violation Description:** This facility is currently in violation with the food handler certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food handlers must obtain a valid food handler certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food handler certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
