Inspector Comments: Follow up inspection was conducted on this day.

Information provided by operator:

- Per operator they cleared and removed all signs of rodent activity.
- Aisles were sanitized using SaniSave, provided by EcoLabs.
- Affected items were discarded.
- Per pest control 8 rats and 6 mice were removed from the facility.
- Per operator the pet food aisle and aisle 8 (baking goods) were the only areas that had signs of rodent activity.
- Pet food shelving was replaced with a sealed wood material.
- Areas behind the refrigeration unit adjacent to the pet food aisle were opened and checked for rodent activity. Rodents were observed to be inside the refrigeration units.
- Areas with rodent activity were cleaned and sealed to prevent reentry.
- Pest control will follow up and recheck affected areas and permanently seal areas once no more signs are visible.
- Entry points were sealed with wire mesh and spray foam.
- Per management they will discontinue over stocking their shelves, allowing them to better observed the shelving areas for any activity in the future.

Areas inspected:

- Meat department
- Bakery
- Deli
- Produce
- Prepackage foods
- Back storage area
- Pizza

Observations:

- Aisles that showed signs of rodent activity were observed to be cleaned and no signs of rodent activity were observed at time of reinspection.
- Possible entry or harborage areas were observed to be sealed with spray foam.
- Areas with high concentration of fecal matter were cleaned and sanitized.
- Spilled sugar with shredded paper pieces were found in the sugar section of the aisle 8 (Baking goods). Was unable to find the affected bag of sugar.
- Hole in wall of produce walk-in refrigerator.

Closure sign was removed and shredded before a San Bernardino County Environmental Health employee could retrieve it.

Follow up will be conducted to verify that facility has remained vermin free.

Facility Permit reinstated on this day.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

Overall Inspection Comments

Follow up reinspection conducted on this day.

Facility permit was suspended on 2/12/2019 for evidence of a rodent infestation.
