Inspector Comments: A follow up inspection was conducted on this date to verify compliance of violations noted during routine inspection.

Upon reinspection, the following violations have been corrected:

Facility has cleaned and sanitized most areas affected by rodent droppings. Pest control invoices were provided and are treating weekly. Gaps and cracks throughout the facility have been filled and covered.

Observed dry rodent droppings on the floor under the following equipment:

- On the floor under the chip rack
- Behind the two ATM machines
- On the shelves near the baby diapers and wipes
- Under the crates holding the 2-liter soda bottles

Ensure to clean and sanitize affected areas and maintain facility free of vermin. A follow up billable reinspection at a minimum rate of \$122.50 per half hour will be conducted on 4/8/22 to verify compliance.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.
