Inspector Comments: A complaint inspection was conducted on this date 4/20/2021 based on a complaint received by Environmental Health Services. Complaint had stated that they had observed a rodent run into the kitchen and upon leaving the facility observed rodents in the exterior back area of the facility.

Upon questioning Operator they had stated they were not aware of the complaint and had not seen or noticed any rodents in the facility. Operator provided invoices for previous Pest Control service with most recent pest control having been conducted in January of 2021, 3 months prior to time of inspection. Upon inspection evidence was observed that facility is currently experiencing an active rodent infestation. Rodent droppings were observed in multiple areas throughout the facility specifically in the kitchen and food storage areas. Excessive amounts of rodent traps were observed throughout the facility. Exterior premises of facility was also inspected with dumpster area observed to have excessive food garbage around and underneath. Dumpster area is located directly outside near the back entrance of the facility. Approaching the near by bushes next to dumpsters prompted loud rustling and movement from within but was unable to verify source of sound and movement.

Facility was closed on this date 4/20/2021 and permit was suspended.

A routine inspection was conducted in conjunction with complaint inspection. See Official Inspection Report for details on violations observed.
