Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit was to conduct a follow-up inspection in order to verify that facility has eliminated cockroach infestation, which led to closure on July 26 , 2019. Manager completed a Supervisory review on July 30, 2019. Manager was advised to ensure that facility is completely free of vermin before contacting Environmental Health Services for re-opening.

Observation (s)

- A detailed inspection was conducted throughout facility.
- Observed no signs of vermin throughout facility.
- Observed gaps between base cove and wall were properly sealed.

Conclusion

- No violations observed , facility may re-open.
- A follow-up inspection will be conducted on August 8, 2019 to verify that facility remains free of vermin.
- Continue to maintain facility free of vermin and ensure to maintain any unapproved openings sealed at all times.
- Complaint closed at this time.
