Inspector Comments: This purpose of this visit was to conduct a routine inspection and a permit investigation.

On this date, the access of this food facility was denied by an employee. The employee stated this food facility barely opens and remodeling exterior. Inspector asked for the access for inspection, but denied again. Observed removed tables and seats through outside window. Any permitted facility by San Bernardino County Environmental Health Department must grant access to facility for inspection.

Our records indicate that your San Bernardino County health permit to operate this food facility has outstanding balance that included delinquency of payment plan for 2018/2019 health permit fee and 2020 health permit fee. Ensure to submit your payment to San Bernardino County health department and renew your health permit or this health permit to operate this food facility will be suspended within 72 hours. Once suspended you may not operate this food facility under this health permit.

A reinspection will be conducted on or after Wednesday, 01/13/2021, to determine compliance. Non-compliance will result in the health permit suspension and the facility closure.
