Inspector Comments: Observed sewage backup in progress with all drains full of standing water. The floor under the three compartment sink and restroom observed to be contaminated by the overflow.

DIRECTIVE:

You are ordered closed and will remain closed until you are reopened by a representative of San Bernardino County Public Health / Environmental Health Services Division.

Steps to be taken before requesting a re-opening inspection:

1) Unobstruct all drains. All drains in the facility must be observed to be free flowing.

2) Sanitize the floors throughout the facility. If using bleach, ensure the mopping solution contains at least one hundred (100) parts per million chlorine.

Once the floors have been sanitized, please call 1-800-442-2283 to arrange for a reinspection.

**Violation Description:** All liquid waste must drain to an approved fully functioning sewage disposal system. (114197) Toilet facilities must be operable.
